THESE CIRCLES SHOW THE GOLDEN ARROW ON ONE SIDE AND DAYTONA BEACH ON THE OTHER, WHERE IT BROKE THE LAND SPEED RECORD IN 1929.

1. COLOUR IN THE TWO PICTURES.
2. CUT ALONG THE SOLID LINES AND FOLD ALONG THE DOTTED LINE.
3. TAPE A STICK (USE A PENCIL OR DOWEL) TO THE BACK OF ONE OF THE CIRCLES WITH THE TOP OF THE STICK ROUGHLY IN THE CENTRE OF THE CIRCLE.
4. GLUE THE TWO CIRCLES TOGETHER.

AS YOU TWIST THE DOWEL YOU WILL SEE YOUR TWO PICTURES MERGE INTO ONE.
